



## Headmaster Letter

What a fun time seeing so many of you at the Fall Festival! The food was scrumptious, the bounce houses looked like great fun, the gift baskets were out of this world, and the dunk tank was . . . well, wet! **Please see note of thanks below.**

I am so excited for this week as we are prepare for our first annual Read-A-Thon on Friday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>. This year we are focused on raising money for the North Phoenix Library. Students will be read out loud to and participate in reading related activities all day (half-day schedule). Students will also be allowed to dress up as their favorite literary character for the day. **We have a goal to raise \$50K in order to establish the North Phoenix Library with shelving, furniture, technology and books to be used by both Archway and Prep students.** We will raise money three ways;

- 1) Sponsorship of students participating in the Read-A-Thon on Friday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>
- 2) Book sale for classroom literature books; held in future home of North Phoenix Library, 8-11:30 am, November 3<sup>rd</sup>
- 3) Commemorative giving opportunities

A complete Read-a-Thon packet went home with students on Tuesday of last week. The packet included a sponsor sheet, literary figure dress-up guidelines, a flyer about the book sale for much needed classroom literature (to be held in future location of the library), and commemorative giving opportunities.

The ANP community raised \$38k last spring for the K-6 playground through the sponsorship of students in our Healthy Hearts for Great Hearts Jump Rope Campaign. I am confident that we can raise additional monies necessary for our library.

Parents are encouraged to contact their student's teacher and sign-up to read to their student's class. We are also in need of parent volunteers to help with the Classroom Literature Book Sale. Please click [HERE](#) to sign up. Prep students will be taking part in reading to the younger students as well. It will be a wonderful time doing what we love to do - READ!
