Elks Lodge Parking Lot

It has come to our attention that many parents are illegally parking and dropping students off in the fire lane located on the south side of the Elks Lodge property. Late Pick-up Policy

The grace period for the **ANP Late Pick-up Policy** will end this week as our traffic signs are scheduled to be put into place throughout the North Phoenix campus on Friday, September 22nd. The signs will assist families in determining the correct lane to be in for the Archway and Prep students, identify 'student parking only', communicate 'right turn only' exits, and will include reminders about the non-use of cell phones.

Parents have asked if this pertains to the Prep sibling pick-up as there is concern that Prep students are unable to get to their siblings by 3:30 pm. We have found there to be no real issues here as Prep students have been extremely responsible in picking up their siblings in a timely manner. If we find that this is not happening, parents will be notified to see if the situation needs further refinement.

Student Tutoring

Tutoring began last week and **takes place on Tuesdays and Thursdays, from 3:20 - 3:50 pm**. Please read below for clarity on ANP tutoring procedures. If you have questions, please contact your child's teacher.

- New student tutoring has ended for 3rd - 6th grade, **with the exception of 6th grade Latin on Mondays from 3:20 - 3:50 pm**.
- **Tutoring is by invitation only**, and if your child is invited to attend, you will receive a notice from your child's teacher.
- Please confirm with your child's teacher that your child will be attending tutoring. If the teacher does not receive confirmation, then your child will be dismissed at normal dismissal time.
- There is no charge for this tutoring. It is intended for students who clearly need remediation in Language Arts and Math.
- If you did not receive an invitation for tutoring but desire tutoring for your child, a list of tutors is provided on the website, and we encourage you to pursue this avenue.
- Tutoring students are dismissed on the north side of the K-4 building (the same spot as regular dismissal). Teachers will wait with students until a parent either drives or walks up to pick up their student. Please be sure to have your blue card with you.
- Parents arriving after 4:00 pm will need to walk into the K-4 lobby to pick students up from the Dean's Office.

- **The Late Pick-up Policy for tutoring will begin being enforced on September 25th.**
- If you have one student attending tutoring and another that is not, the student that is not in tutoring needs to be picked up at the regular dismissal time. We do not have resources to watch siblings who are not attending tutoring. In such situations, the Late Pick-Up Policy will apply.
- If your Archway student is normally picked up by a Prep sibling, the Prep sibling may pick up the Archway student, after tutoring, from the north side of the K-4 building at 3:50 pm. Non-tutoring students need to be picked up by Prep siblings at the normal dismissal time.
