



ANP Read-A-Thon and North Phoenix Library Fundraiser Literary Figure Dress-up Guidelines

The goal for our students in dressing up as a literary figure during our Read-A-Thon is to celebrate the virtues and qualities of character that your child adores. Teachers and faculty will be joining in on the celebration by dressing up and all students are encouraged to do the same. Please follow the guidelines set forth below when putting a costume together for your child. It is not required that your child dress up, but it is of course highly encouraged. 1. The costume must be of a literary figure that is part of the Archway North Phoenix curriculum. You can access the literature reading list here: <http://archwaynorthphoenix.greatheartsacademies.org/wp-content/uploads/sites/22/2017/05/Literature-library-2017-2018-BN.pdf>
2. The costume should cover at least the same areas as the Archway polo and shorts/skirts (just above the knee). No skinny jeans or leggings alone should be worn.
3. Items in your costume should not have any logos or pop-culture reference on them.
4. Shoes must remain in uniform (white tennis shoes).
5. Masks are NOT permitted. Face paint is only permitted if it is an integral part of the costume and should be minimal. (Whiskers are acceptable, but a green face is not.)
6. Small props are allowed, but they should be put away during class and recess. Play swords and other knightly accoutrements must be kept sheathed.
7. Students who do not follow the guidelines for dress-up day may be sent home.
