



Headmaster Letter

Dear Archway Families and Friends,

First, congratulations to Parker Tellis, the winner of 2018 ANP Bard Competition! Parker recited *St. Crispin's Day Speech* from the William Shakespeare play, *Henry V, Act IV Scene iii 18-6*. There were many wonderfully recited poems, some of which brought tears to the judges eyes. I was not able to attend the competition, but was able to view a few of them by video and I can't express how very proud I am of our students who have embraced a passion for words and poetry. Second, there has been a lot of talk in the media regarding school safety since the tragedy that took place in Parkland, Florida. We have received several emails, phone calls, and voiced concerns about the safety on our campus and inquiries as to what changes are being made in the wake of this tragedy. We are fortunate to have Mr. Page, who has experience in this area, to lead the school in campus safety. We are directing the majority of the questions that have come up to him directly in order to give consistent and concise answers. We have made some immediate changes, including the locking of the front doors at all times, and leadership at the Great Hearts lead office is helping us to determine other courses of action to take in the near future and into the next school year. It has been suggested that we have some sort of "town hall meeting/Headmaster coffee" to address parent concerns as well as the various possibilities. Please know that I hear your concerns and we will work to get something scheduled during the first half of the 4th quarter. Thank you for your patience in this as we attempt to understand all that is involved.

Third, we are looking forward to our K-4 field day this Friday! This an exciting day for our students and faculty alike to compete at several athletic events organized and planned by our PE department. As a reminder, student dress code is still in effect. Girls are encouraged to wear uniform shorts/pants instead of a skirt/jumper. If a skirt is worn, a pair of black or navy shorts must be worn underneath. Students will be given Field Day shirts in their classrooms on Friday that may be worn over their uniform shirts.

Finally, let me wish all of you a relaxing and restful spring break next week. Your students deserve the much awaited break and I hope that you are all able to enjoy some beautiful weather and make some lasting memories.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Field Day weather forecast appears to be sunny and the high of 86, which is warmer than normal temperature this time of year! I'm sure this will be the highlight of the year for most of the kids. Please take into consideration a few things:

- 1.) Sunscreen- please insist on it for each child. Parents, please apply before coming to school!! Non logo hats and sunglasses are permitted.
- 2.) Water - kids who are running around should be drinking 7 to 10 cups of water for the day; kids will begin to dehydrate in the sun at an increased rate; they will begin to wilt without water and might pass out after 3 hours in the sun without proper fluid replacement. Water breaks will be provided. Any student that does not bring a water bottle will be at risk of not being able to participate.
- 3.) Food and snacks - please insist that children have full lunches/snacks and eat a hearty breakfast.
- 4.) If medical issues arise, I will be available to help along with Nurse Krich.
