Please plan to arrive early on the day your scholar is performing in order to park and find your place on the field; morning performers will need to be on campus by 7:20, and parents of afternoon performers should arrive by around 2:45. **N.B. Parents of afternoon performers should arrive by 11:45 AM on Nov. 21 and by 1:45 PM on Nov. 28 due to earlier dismissal times on those days.**

Parking will be available at Paradise Valley Baptist Church. You may park in the lot west of the church and then exercise caution crossing Hearn Street. Traffic attendants will be present. Please **do not park on campus** for this event. There is not a sufficient number of parking spaces available.

Open Enrollment

Great Hearts Open Enrollment for the 2019-20 School Year is held November 14 thru December 7, 2018.

Open Enrollment is for NEW APPLICANTS only. If your child currently attends Archway Academy North Phoenix, you do not need to submit an application at this time.*

Re-Enrollment information will be emailed to current students in March for the 2019-20 school year. At that time you will have the opportunity to Re-Enroll your child (indicate your intent to return) for the upcoming school year.

***Current GRADE 6 Students**

Grade 6 is the highest grade level offered at Archway Academy North Phoenix and is considered a graduation grade.

Students scheduled to graduate from our academy are *not* automatically enrolled into grade 7 at our designated recipient school, North Phoenix Preparatory Academy. [You will need to submit a new application to North Phoenix Preparatory Academy during the open enrollment period](#) in order to be considered for enrollment at that academy for the 2019-20 school year.
